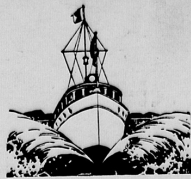


CAPTAIN GEORGE H. MONSELL

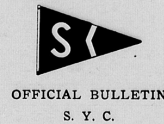
